I was asked to assist the IT department with the project management for the data centralization project and to train the end- and key users and to get them involved in all aspects of the project – including data enrichment.

When I had completed my role in this project, all master data was migrated from the old system and it was now being managed centrally (and synchronized with the local sites) and all 120 key- and end-users had been trained ready for the Go-LIVE.

In this process, I also fulfilled the role of change-coordinator and functional designer for the final required changes.

The customer went live on June 22 2014, apart from some normal go-live-struggles there were no big problems and people worked confidently.
